The Recreation Vehicle (RV) manufacturing industry payroll for 2013 added **\$2.1 billion** to the U.S. economy

RV manufacturers *shipped more than 320,000 RVs* to dealerships nationwide and internationally in 2013, with an estimated *retail value of \$13 billion*

RV manufacturers *directly employ 71,000 people*, with an *industry-wide employment of 344,000 workers*

The RV Caucus focuses on important, current legislative issues, including:

- **Obtaining an amendment** to the National Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Act to assure recreation vehicles (RVs), which are otherwise regulated, are excluded from HUD housing regulations.
- **Calling for long-term renewal of the GSP** - Generalized System of Preferences - because GSP expiration costs each RV manufacturer more than *one million dollars* per year.
- **Supporting reauthorization of FLREA** and **including the Army Corps of Engineers recreation fees** so that annual passes to federal recreation lands can continue to be sold in 2015 and critical outdoor recreation areas that are important to RV users and all Americans can be maintained and improved.
