On behalf of the Executive Standards Council (ExSC), I am pleased to inform you that the reaccreditation the **Recreational Vehicle Industry Association** under its recently revised operating procedures for documenting consensus on RVIA-sponsored *American National Standards* has been approved effective **August 14, 2015**. Please forward to my attention a final, clean copy of RVIA's revised procedures, with the changes highlighted in the revised procedures attached to your March 11, 2015 communication to ANSI (along with any additional changes requested by staff) accepted in the document. The ExSC and its Audit Subcommittee reserve the right to request additional changes to RVIA's accredited procedures as a result of any new procedural requirements issued with future versions of the *ANSI Essential Requirements*, or if any instances of non-compliance missed during the current review are later identified during a subsequent audit.
